

Please do not send your child into school with a backpack- their coats and a drawstring PE kitbag should be all that is on their pegs. Our school also had an <u>Attendance Audit</u> this week, with the School Education Welfare Officer. She has inspected our registers and spoken in detail with us about the children who are not currently attaining a good level of attendance.
