Welcome back to school everyone! This is usually the busiest and most exciting half term because Christmas is rapidly approaching. Whilst this year will naturally have to be different, we will be doing our very best to ensure that the children still get to experience the wonder of the season in school.

Thank you to all parents who are remembering to socially distance and wear masks. I sent out an update yesterday reminding you all of the importance of following the Lockdown rules, and really appreciate your help in keeping our school community safe. I realise that it is a chore to remember to wear your masks around our school, but by doing so you are helping to keep us open. Thank you! I know that there has been some confusion about **when a child needs to be tested**if your child has a cough OR a temperature OR loses their sense of smell, they will need a test. They do not have to have all three symptoms, only one symptom is sufficient to warrant a test. Latest reports suggest that the testing has improved and people are receiving their results far quicker than before.

As part of our Covid risk assessment, we will be keeping windows and doors open wherever possible to aid in ventilating the classrooms, so **please ensure that your children have a name labelled jumper and coat at school**, as the classrooms are much colder than usual now that the outside temperature is dropping.


The individual school photographs will be handed out to children early next week, so please keep an eye out for them in your child's bookbag.
