# Literacy,

Next week we will be continuing to enjoy the story 'Penguin on Holiday' and writing postcards from the beach! We will be learning new vocabulary such as, sea, tide, beach, sand, rocks, cliffs as well as looking at the features of the seaside.

## Maths Activity

This week we have been looking at doubles. If you have a set of dominos at home, can you ask your child to pick out the double dominos? Can they tell you the double number sentence e.g. **'Double 3 is 6. 6 is made from 3 and 3'**. Now can they find a 'not double' (any domino which doesn't have the same number of dots on each side. Can they explain why it is a 'not double'? Can they subitise and say how many dots on each side?



Next week we will be continuing to count beyond 20 and noticing the pattern of the counting system. Please continue to count regularly with your child. If you notice that your child struggles to cross the 10s number, just help them to say the next 10 and then let them carry on counting. You could also support your child by counting in steps of 10 and flashing your fingers in 10s as they count "10, 20, 30...."

# Understanding of the World - Comparing holidays from the past and present

As part of our topic, we will be looking at holidays from the past and holidays (and day trips) now. If possible, we would really like your children to talk to their Grandparents to find out what they did as children for their holidays. Where did they go? How did they get there? Where did they stay? What did they do? Encourage your child to think about any holidays or day trips that they have been on. Where did they go? How did they get there? Where did they stay? What did they do? How is it different to their Grandparents' experiences? Please send in any photos of their Grandparents holidays or photos of your child on holiday via email or tapestry as we would love to give the children opportunities to share their experiences and what they have learnt from their Grandparents.



#### Please remember:
