## Important Information Regarding Penalty Notices for Absence

### Penalty Notices: Information from the Educational Welfare Service

As of September 2019 the Penalty Notice Code of Conduct will be re-issued with the following changes:

- If a child has 10 sessions (5 days) absence in a 10 week period (including spanning two terms) Or:
- If a child has 10 Un-authorised Late arrivals in a 10 week period
- Or:
- If a pupil is found in a public place whilst excluded
- Then:

A Penalty Notice will be issued, which is £60 per parent of the pupil. If the Penalty Notice is not paid within a specific time frame, the amount doubles to £120 per parent per pupil.
