Our first full week is done, although it has been a fairly strange one, with a number of us (me included) having to be at home isolating whilst we await our Covid test results. Thankfully, everyone who has been tested has been **negative for Covid**, and so we haven't had to use our plans for pod closure. Thank you to all those parents who are being cautious and who are keeping their children at home if they are showing symptoms and organising tests. I know it can be very frustrating especially if you feel your child simply has a cold or other winter virus, and as it is quite daunting organising testing at the moment, however, by being cautious you are helping to keep the other children and their families safe. A number of our school families have household members who are at risk if they were to catch Covid, and so our efforts to contain and manage the risks of Covid help not only the children but their loved ones too.

As part of some of the changes that we have had to make because of the hygiene and safety requirements, I need to remind parents that we can no longer allow children to hand out sweets/cake at the end of the school day for their birthdays. I know that this will disappoint many of the children, and I hope that we will be able to reinstate this tradition as soon as the risks of infection have reduced.

Please do let us know if you are struggling to access the bulletins, as we will be relying on the website access in the case of a year group or school wide closure.

We also have to clean the structure if children from a different pod have used it, which takes time and uses our cleaning products up quicker.

And finally, Mrs Killick and I will be back out on the playground at drop-off and collection each day and are very happy to answer any questions or help out with any issues.
